

Directions to The Old Dairy, Cadhay, Ottery St Mary from Honiton A30

If travelling from Honiton direction travel along the A30 and turn off at the Ottery St Mary “Iron Bridge” junction onto the Old A30, stay on this road through the village of Fenny Bridges and then follow signs to Escot. The road passes the turning for Feniton on the right and Paterson’s Cross on the left. Take the fork left after this marked “Fairmile and Escot” it brings you down to the Fairmile crossroads with the Old Post Office on your left. Turn left at the crossroads marked to Cadhay.

Be careful as the road narrows here for a while, and is quite twisty, passing a car repair garage on your left but stay on that road which then opens out just after Pitt Farm and follow it along a short distance until you will then see on your left a black sign on the verge with the word “CADHAY” in white writing on it, opposite the sign is a tree lined tarmac drive with a large grey stone Manor house on the left at the top. This is Cadhay House, and our offices are on the estate adjacent to the house. If you reach the stone bridges over the river you have missed the turning.

Turn left and travel up the drive to the top, passing the house on your left. The driveway then turns 90° right and on the left are some old brick and stone farm buildings. We are the first building on the left and have a silver milk churn on the front step and the arrow on the map below shows our location. You can park on the grass either on the right or the left, and the entrance to the office is around the back of the building. If you are using Sat Nav it brings you a different way into the back entrance!
